FOOD AND NUTRITION TEACHER (PART TIME 0.50 – 0.75 FTE) September 2026

This is an exciting opportunity for a passionate Food and Nutrition Teacher. Food and Nutrition is a popular and successful department with modern purpose-built facilities. In years I-III cookery is a core part of the curriculum. Girls may study for GCSE and the EDUQAS syllabus is followed. In the Sixth Form girls may take the Leiths CTH Level 3 Extended Certificate in Professional Cookery. This course is fully accredited by the Confederation of Tourism and Hospitality enabling this qualification to be recognised worldwide. It also carries UCAS points for those girls planning on attending University. Leiths is an important part of the School's offering and helps girls develop practical culinary skills by focusing on scratch cooking skills, advance techniques and strict food safety.

A PGCE is not essential for this role and alternative qualifications such as Leith's Food Teacher Training or a Level 7 Certificate in Professional Development for Food Education will be considered. The post holder will need to be able to demonstrate strong culinary practical skills and the ability to apply them to curriculum delivery. There is the requirement to work a Saturday morning and the potential for two evenings a week.

Tudor Hall is a girls' boarding school with a strong sense of community. Our pupils consistently achieve excellent results in public examinations and across the co-curriculum.
